Ralph Forquera, a member of the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians is the Executive Director for the Seattle Indian Health Board, one of the largest and most comprehensive urban Indian community health centers in the nation. Mr. Forquera was a co-author of the first and only population-based study on the health status of urban American Indians and Alaskan Natives which was published in the Journal of the American Medical Association.
